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LSU Scientists Improve Storm Forecasting

Computer scientists, coastal scientists and engineers at LSU are working to improve a critical tool that is widely used to predict the effects of large storms as they approach the coast. They are making the ADCIRC multi-scale coastal circulation computer model faster and more dynamic.
