LSU, Tulane Faculty Partner to Host “Scientific Computing Around Louisiana”

BATON ROUGE – LSU's Center for Computation & Technology, or CCT, and Tulane University's Center for Computational Science will co-sponsor Scientific Computing Around Louisiana, or SCALA, for a second year. This year, the event will be held at Tulane University January 28-29.

SCALA 2011 will feature invited lectures by Robert H. Dillon, Washington State University; Beatrice Riviere, Rice University; and Daniel Szyld, Temple University. There will also be contributed presentations and discussion sessions.

Professors Susanne C. Brenner, CCT and LSU Department of Mathematics, and Lisa J. Fauci, Tulane University, created SCALA to highlight cutting-edge topics in scientific computing, showcase research that is taking place in Louisiana, and promote collaborations across the state.

Faculty, postdoctoral researchers, or students from colleges and universities in or around Louisiana are welcome to attend. Registration is free, but required.
